Wednesday Night “Live at the Auburn Public Theater” \$5

This site has just opened as a downtown community center with public venues for art exhibits, acting space and a place for informal music and small concerts. A mix between an open mike type format and participation from Finger Lakes Area musicians (including our own **Bob Brower**) guarantees a great night of music, covering a wide range of styles, full of unique musical signatures. Bring a guitar and add to the fun at the Finger Lakes newest underground music scene. Tonight’s activities include a space to socialize, pizza and salad and a cash bar available.

Historic Sites Tour: \$20

Auburn is the home of five “Save America’s Treasures” site and several National Historic Landmarks (NHL). This excursion tour will visit the **Willard Memorial Chapel** (only existing known complete Tiffany Religious interior), the **William Henry Seward House Museum** (U.S. Secretary of State and recent “Team of Rivals” and “Manhunt” books fame), **Harriet Tubman** (the National Underground Railroad Leader – future National Park Service project), and ending at **Emerson Park** (Historic Lakeside Park on the north end of Owasco Lake). After the opening reception at Emerson Park Pavilion, stay for a buffet dinner in the historic “Lake Side Pavilion” Restaurant. Located along the northern shore of Owasco Lake in the Heart of the Finger Lakes, the pavilion was built in 1912 at a Victorian Pleasure Park encouraging train and trolley riders to “weekend at the lake” with various dances and “big band concerts” during the 1940’s. The grand veranda has a commanding view sitting over Owasco Lake, one of the central Finger Lakes.
